

Colorado Access to Recovery III (ATR III) Eligibility Criteria*

Colorado ATR III is a four-year grant from the Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT) providing expanded Treatment and Recovery Support Services (RSS) for individuals with Substance Abuse and Dependence in Colorado. "ATR Admissions" will screen each individual requesting ATR services based on the eligibility criteria listed below.

In order to be eligible for **Substance Abuse Treatment & RSS Services**, individuals must meet the following criteria:

1. Populations Served: Ages 12 and over.
2. Have a Substance Abuse or Dependence problem requiring treatment, regardless of substance [excluding nicotine] (**Outpatient services ONLY**).
3. Be a current Colorado resident.
4. Have no private or public health insurance or funding for Substance Abuse treatment, including Medicaid.
5. Are not court-ordered to treatment or currently involved in the criminal justice system, including probation and parole or currently charged with "Driving Under the Influence" or "Minor in Possession" charges.
6. Participate in an independent assessment of treatment needs conducted by "ATR Admissions".
7. Receive services from ATR contracted providers.

In order to be eligible for **Recovery Support Services**, individuals must meet the following criteria:

1. Populations Served: Ages 12 and over.
2. Be currently in Substance Abuse treatment or have completed Substance Abuse treatment within the past 30 days or are currently actively involved in a recovery process with their DBH or ATR Provider.
3. Be referred by their Division of Behavioral Health (DBH) Licensed Substance Abuse Treatment Provider or currently contracted ATR Provider by having that provider fax the "**ATR Provider Referral Form**" to "ATR Admissions" (303-832-9701 or 303-951-3325). Form is available at www.ATRColorado.org.
4. Be a current Colorado resident.
5. Participate in an independent assessment of Recovery Support Service needs conducted by "ATR Admissions".
6. Receive services from ATR contracted providers.

Eligible individuals may call 888-CARE 616 or 303-953-4053 [Mon. – Fri. 8:30 – 5:00] to be screened for eligibility and assessment by "ATR Admissions"
